Green = Viridis



Violet = Violaceus



Orange = Aurantia



3 HABITAT

Name your microbe based on where it lives!



Sea or ocean
= Marinus



Aquatic = Aquaticus



Forest = Sylvaticus



Ground or soil = Terrestris



Heat-loving = Thermophilus



Cold-loving = Psychrophilus



Salt-loving = Halophilus
